#### Mosquito Alert



We are currently experiencing a lot of Mosquitos at school, particularly in the early morning. Please spray your children in the morning before school. NT Health have released the following alert:

NT Health are warning teachers, educators and students of higher numbers of salt marsh mosquitoes in NT coastal areas throughout October and November.

Salt marsh mosquitoes are aggressive biters during the day and can transmit Ross River Virus.

NT Health is urging schools and early childhood services to minimise the impact of mosquitoes on young children, infants and teachers by:

- Staying indoors when mosquito numbers are noted to be very high
- Wear light-coloured long-sleeved shirts, long pants and socks
- Use insect repellents that contain DEET, picaridin or oil of lemon eucalyptus (PMD), as per label advice.





Students have been showing their success using picture graphs and column graphs.










We have participated in public safety activities, with focus on the Daniel Morcombe Foundation.
